

Signs of the Times Show 2

The following Show Notes are for reference to be used while listening to the series of 'Signs of the Times' on 'Return to the Threshing Floor' broadcast.

Analogy: A Play on Broadway: Synopsis - Invitation – Players and Events – We are also participants within the Play - Missing Piece – Script> Parts are now in full view.

At the Opening of the Curtain: Sealing of the 144,000, Binding of the Serpents and Scorpions, Blowing of the Trumpets, Opening of the Seals, Pouring of the Vials, Abomination of Desolation, Satan cast down, Satan sitting in his temple, Fig Tree shooting forth, Battle of Armageddon, Gog Magog war, 144,000 flee Babylon 144,000 flee to the mountains, Woman in the Wilderness appears, The Beast rises up out of the sea, The Beast which is the false prophet is soon to appear, The 7 churches are judged.

The Players on the Stage

Serpents, Scorpions, Multitude: Who are they, What are their characteristics, and what is their role during the Tribulation?

Serpents: They are pious, better than thou, and arrogant. They are in a position of power. They are in the role of the Pharisees, Sadducees, and Scribes in the Judas Cycle. Jesus called them serpents and vipers.

Scorpions: They are covetous, they are greedy. They want what you have. They are envious of what you possess. These are the ones that will be turning in their brothers, mothers, daughters, fathers, friends, and neighbors for their reward. They are in the role of Judas in the Judas Cycle.

Multitude: They unknowing are sinning against God. Yet they really do love Jesus Christ. They have chosen to listen to fables and follow false doctrines, the doctrines of man, i.e. Christmas, Easter, Rapture, and physical Jews are the chosen people. They will die in their sins unless God gets them out of their comfortable places. They are in the role of Jesus in the Judas Cycle. The innocent being crucified and killed.

The 144,000 are not on the stage. They teach the Multitude as to the reason they are on the stage.

144,000: These are they which are pure before the Lord. They speak the Truth. They have been chosen. They will teach the Multitude the error of their ways and encourage

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them to be accepting of their punishment and strengthen them to endure to the end. These are the workers in the field. These are Christians who have come out of the apostate church. These are they which have rejected the doctrines of man and have embraced the Truth of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Is this the time of the end?

Daniel 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Daniel 12:9 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end.

Amos 3:7 Surely the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.

Revealth: 1540. *hlg galah, gaw-law' a primitive root; to denude...by implication, to exile (captives being usually stripped); figuratively, to reveal...(carry, lead, go) captive (into captivity), ...disclose, ... reveal, ... uncover.*

Denude: Merriam Webster Dict:...2a: to strip of all covering or surface layers...

Secret: 03245. *doy yacad, yaw-sad' ... to set (literally or figuratively... establish, (lay the, lay for a) found(-ation), instruct, lay, ordain, set...*

“The Sign”

Matthew 24:3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?

Mr 13:4 Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign when all these things shall be fulfilled?

Lu 21:7 And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign will there be when these things shall come to pass?

The definition for the word 'sign' in each of these verses is the same word.

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Sign: 4592. *semeion, say-mi'-on ...from 4591; an indication, especially ceremonially or supernaturally:--miracle, sign, token, wonder.*

4591 *semaino, say-mah'-ee-no from sema (a mark; of uncertain derivation); to indicate:--signify.*

Matthew 24:3 ...and what shall be the **sign of thy coming**...?

Matthew – “Sign of **thy coming**” is synonymous with the “**coming of the Son of Man,**”

Mt 24:27 For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; **so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.**

Mt 24:37 But as the days of Noe were, **so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.**

Mt 24:39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; **so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.**

In the above verses it tells us that certain events or things are also known as. ‘**AKA**’ “For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west”, “But as the days of Noe were, “and knew not until the flood came.”

These are clues that tell us what to be looking for “the sign” at the start of the Tribulation. What is “**For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west**” This is a clue to watch for. What is meant by “**But as the days of Noe were**” This is a clue to watch for. What is “**And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away.**” Another clue to watch for. What do these clues mean. These clues are actually connected to the sign we need to be watchful for.

We will come back to these later. Right now we want to stay focused on Matthew 24:3, Mark 13:4, and Luke 21:7.

End of the World – What is meant by that phrase?

Matthew 24:3 ...and what shall be the sign of thy coming...**and of the end of the world ...?**

The “sign of thy coming” is tied to “and the end of the world.”

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End of the world is not referring to the globe or entire earth. It is referring to the Apostate church. Remember – Judgment begins at the House of God. The Tribulation is focused on the ‘church’ not the entire world’s population. The Bible is for the church.

Isa 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

When and how did the LORD proclaim to “the end of the world”? The Bible is His proclamation. The prophets of the Old Testament and New Testament, Jesus Christ and the apostles have spoken and taught of these things.

Who is the daughter of Zion? First we need to identify Zion.

Zion 6726 Tsiyown, tsee-yone' the same...as 6725; Tsijon (as a permanent capital), a mountain of Jerusalem:--Zion.

Re 14:1 ¶ And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.

4622 Sion, see-own' of Hebrew origin (6726); Sion (i.e. Tsijon), a hill of Jerusalem; **figuratively, the Church** (militant or triumphant):--Sion.

Zion or Sion is where the Lamb is with 144,000. The 144,000 are the Woman in the Wilderness. Therefore, the daughter of Zion is the Man-Child, AKA the Multitude, that the Woman AKA, the (144,000) gives birth to.

The daughter of Zion doesn't receive her salvation until the vengeance of the Lord has been accomplished through the period we know as the Tribulation. His reward to them is eternal salvation. His work before him is the Tribulation as he has proclaimed. Another verse that gives us more insight as to what the “end of the world” is referring to.

Mt 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

In this verse, the harvest is the end of the world. The harvest is the persecution and execution of the Multitude.

Mt 13:49 So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just,

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In this verse, the angels are severing the wicked from the just. This is the binding of the tares. This is the unholy alliance of the Serpents and the Scorpions being separated from the just, the Multitude.

The “end of the world” is also known as “the harvest” and also known as the severing of the wicked from the just. Both of these ‘event’s’ are processes that occur during the Tribulation.

End 4930 *sunteleia*, soon-tel'-i-ah 4931; *entire completion, i.e. consummation (of a dispensation):--end.*

4931 *sunteleo*, soon-tel'-eh'-o from 4862 and 5055; *to complete entirely; generally, to execute (literally or figuratively):--end, finish, fulfil, make.*

4862 *sun*, soon a primary preposition denoting union; *with or together...process... beside, with. In composition it has similar applications, including completeness.*

5055 *teleo*, tel'-eh'-o from 5056; *to end, i.e. complete, execute, conclude, discharge (a debt):--accomplish, make an end, expire, fill up, finish, go over, pay, perform.*

5056 *telos*, tel'-os from a primary *tello* (to set out for a definite point or goal); *properly, the point aimed at as a limit, i.e. (by implication) the conclusion of an act or state (termination (literally, figuratively or indefinitely), result (immediate, ultimate or prophetic), purpose); specially, an impost or levy (as paid)....end(-ing)... Compare 5411.*

5411 *phoros*, for'-os from 5342; *a load (as borne), i.e. (figuratively) a tax (properly, an individual assessment on persons or property); whereas 5056 is usually a general toll on goods or travel):--tribute.*

The word Fulfilled.

Now let's take a look at the item that is tied to the sign of His coming in Mark, fulfilled.

Mr 13:4 ...and what shall be the sign when all these things shall be fulfilled?

There is another verse in Luke 21 that starts to tie in other phrases with the term 'fulfilled'.

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Lu 21:22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.

The fulfilling or fulfilled has within it “**the days of vengeance**”. Didn’t we quote a verse with that terminology in it on the last show? Remember, Judgement = Vengeance.

Jer 51:6 Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the time of the LORD'S vengeance; he will render unto her a recompence.

Let’s look at some other verses that contain the phrase “**be fulfilled.**”

Lu 21:24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled.

Lu 21:32 Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled.**

The phrase “be fulfilled” can AKA “the days of vengeance”, the times of the Gentiles, and a generation that sees these things being fulfilled. Let’s take a look at the definition of ‘fulfilled.’

Fulfilled 4931 *sunteleo*, *soon-tel-eh'* from 4862 and 5055; to complete entirely; generally, to execute (literally or figuratively):--end, finish, fulfil, make.

The definition of word ‘end’ from the phrase ‘**end of the world**’ is 4930 from 4931. So, the ‘**end of the world**’ and ‘**when all these things shall be fulfilled?**’ are essentially the same thing and are synonymous with each other.

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5056 telos, tel'-os from a primary tello (to set out for a definite point or goal); properly, the point aimed at as a limit, i.e. (by implication) the conclusion of an act or state (termination (literally, figuratively or indefinitely), result (immediate, ultimate or prophetic), purpose); specially, **an impost or levy** (as paid)....end(-ing)... Compare 5411.

5411 phoros, for'-os from 5342; a load (as borne), i.e. (**figuratively**) **a tax (properly, an individual assessment on persons or property)**; whereas 5056 is usually a general toll on goods or travel):--tribute.

5342 phero, fer'-o a primary verb...to "bear" or carry (in a very wide application, literally and figuratively, as follows):--be, bear, **bring (forth)**...endure...reach...

“These things shall come to pass?”

Lu 21:7 ...what sign will there be when these things shall **come to pass?**

Come to Pass 1096 ginomai, ghin'-om-ahē ...form of a primary verb; to cause to be ... i.e. (reflexively) to become (come into being)...**be assembled**,...be brought (to pass), ...come (to pass),... **be divided**, ...be end,... be finished,...**be married**, be ordained to be, partake,...**be published**,...**be taken**,...**wax**,...

Be assembled – Serpents and Scorpions, **Be divided** – division of the current apostate church- Serpents, Scorpions, Multitude – division of Ezekiel's hair, **Be married** – 5 wise virgins (144,000) go into the marriage with the Bridegroom, **Be published** – Mt 24:14, **Be taken** – One shall be taken (5 foolish virgins – Multitude), one shall be left (5 wise virgins – 144,000), **Wax** – love of many shall wax cold Matthew 24:12.
