“White supremacy and domestic terrorist organizations have no place in America. 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Matthew 24:15-18 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, **stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)** **Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:** Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house: Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

Mr 13:14-16 But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, **(let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:** And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take any thing out of his house: And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment.

Lu 21:20-22 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. **Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains;** and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto. For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.

Luke 21:21 **Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains;**

Stand in the Holy Place – What is the Holy Place? Where is it?, Flee to the mountains – What mountains? Where are the mountains?

Mountains: 3735 oros, or'-os probably from an obsolete oro (to rise or "rear"; **perhaps akin to 142;** compare 3733); **a mountain** as lifting itself above the plain): -hill, mount(-ain).

Single Mountain – not mountains. There is a single mountain spoken about in Revelations.

Re 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the **mount Sion**, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.

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Single mountain again – rising above the plain – the plain is where the Serpents, the Scopions, and the Multitude are located

142 airo, *ah'-ee-ro* a primary root; **to lift up**; by implication, **to take up or away**; figuratively, **to raise (the voice)**... **to sail away**...**bear (up), carry, lift up**...

3733 ornis, *or'-nis* probably from a prolonged form of the base of 3735; **a bird (as rising in the air)**, i.e. (specially), **a hen** (or female domestic fowl):--hen.

Mt 23:37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, **even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings**, and ye would not!

Sion: 4622 *Sion*, see-own' of Hebrew origin (6726); *Sion* (i.e. *Tsijon*), **a hill of Jerusalem; figuratively, the Church (militant or triumphant)**:--Sion.

2Ti 2:3, 4 Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good **soldier** of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a **soldier**.

Two different words used in this passage for 'soldier'.

Soldier 4757 stratiotes, *strat-ee-o'-tace* from a presumed derivative of the same as 4756; **a camper-out**, i.e. a (**common**) **warrior** (literally or figuratively):--**soldier**.

Camper-out: n. a person who **camps out** for recreation, **especially in the wilderness**. a person who attends a summer camp or day camp.

4756 stratia, *strat-ee'-ah* feminine of a derivative of *stratos* (**an army**; from the base of 4766, as *encamped*); **camp-likeness**, i.e. an army, i.e. (figuratively) the angels, the celestial luminaries:--host.

4766 stronnumi, *strone'-noo-mee* (probably akin to 4731 through the idea of **positing**); to "**strew**," i.e. **spread**... furnish, spread, strew.

Positing: v. 1. **assume as a fact; put forward as a basis of argument**. 2. **put in position; place**.

Isn't the definition of positing exactly what preaching 'This Gospel' is?

4731 stereos, *ster-eh-os'* from 2476; stiff, i.e. **solid, stable** (literally or figuratively):--**stedfast, strong, sure**.

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2476 *histemi*, his'-tay-mee a prolonged form of a primary stao stah'-o...**to stand ... establish...set (up)...stand...**

Soldier: 4758 *stratologeō*, strat-ol-og-eh'-o from a compound of the base of 4756 and 3004 (in its original sense); **to gather (or select) as a warrior, i.e. enlist in the army:-- choose to be a soldier.**

4756 brings us to the definition of the first soldier used in that passage.

3004 *legō*, leg'-o a primary verb; properly, **to "lay" forth**, i.e. **(figuratively) relate (in words (usually of systematic or set discourse))...**

Currently "This Gospel" is being preached and published which includes the training of the 144,000. Then the 144,000 will teach and train the Multitude. What does a soldier do? They prepare for war by putting on their uniforms.

Eph 6:11-18 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. **Stand therefore**, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; Stand therefore – Standing on Mount Zion with the Lord Jesus Christ dressed as soldiers of Christ with the whole armour of God. Back to the definition of Zion.

Sion 06726 *Tsiyown*, tsee-yone' the same (regularly) as 6725; *Tsijon* (as a permanent capital), **a mountain of Jerusalem**:--Zion.

06725 *tsiyuwn*, tsee-yoon' from the same as 6723 in the sense of conspicuousness (compare 5329); **a monumental or guiding pillar**:--sign, title, **waymark**.

Waymark: Merriam Webster n. **an object serving as a guide to someone traveling**

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6723 *tsiyah, tsee-yaw' from an unused root meaning to parch...* **solitary place, wilderness.**

Woman in the Wilderness

Rev 12:6 And the woman **fled** into the **wilderness**, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.

Rev 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might **fly** into the **wilderness**, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

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
